## **Submission Guidelines**

The **Journal of International Organization Studies** is a new, peer-reviewed journal that seeks to encourage the creation of a distinct field of international organization studies. It aims to provide a window into the state of the art in international organization research, and function as a platform for interdisciplinary dialog on international organizations.

*JIOS'* mission is to support innovative approaches to the study of international organizations. We particularly welcome papers that explore new grounds and transcend the traditional perspective of international organizations as merely the sum of its members and their policies.

The journal's focus is the analysis and development of IO specific concepts, theories and methodologies. We welcome the full range of theoretical approaches. Theoretical and empirical studies will be hosted in equal proportion.

*JIOS* works across disciplines and therefore especially welcomes meta-disciplinary analyses that will provide a foundation for communication across academic fields and disciplines. We welcome scholarship about specific organizations as well as the phenomenon of international organizations, their structures and processes, and their place in the international community.

The *Journal of International Organization Studies* publishes three types of articles:

- **research manuscripts** (8,000 – 10,000 words, including footnotes and references)
- **reviews** of literature or disciplinary approaches (800 –1,200 words including footnotes and references for book reviews; 2,000 – 3,000 words including footnotes and references for subject reviews)
- **"Insider's View"** (3,000 – 7,000 words, including footnotes and references): contributions from practitioners on the inner workings of international organizations.

Manuscripts accepted for review are evaluated by two scholars active and publishing in the field of international organizations studies in a variety of disciplines. These evaluations support the Editors' decision for publication. The Editors alone are responsible for all final decisions on publication of manuscripts.

Original manuscripts within the aims and scope of *JIOS* may be submitted in one of two ways:

1. **By email:** Authors who wish to submit their article electronically should email to the editors at [editors@journal-iostudies.org](mailto:editors@journal-iostudies.org). Authors should send two file attachments, one of which should have all self-identifying references and language, acknowledgements and authors' names or affiliations removed. All files should contain an abstract of about 150 words.
2. **Online:** *not yet available*

All electronic files should be formatted in Microsoft Word or PDF.

*JIOS* accepts manuscripts for review with the understanding that they are original analyses, have not been published elsewhere, and are not currently under review for publication elsewhere.
